

## Transforming Lives:



At Flat Rock we provide daily, residential treatment for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities. Each of our residents is cared for in a compassionate, Christ-centered environment

by trained, caring staff. To meet the often rigorous demands that individuals with intellectual, developmental and behavioral needs present, our staff work 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year.

Our staff strive daily to not only meet, but exceed the regulations that county, state and other accrediting bodies have outlined for us. We also aim to surpass the expectations that families have placed on us while caring for their children.

Daily residential medical and habilitation needs of our residents are met by funding from Medicaid. However, this funding is often not sufficient to fully enrich and enhance the lives of our more than 100 individuals. To meet this need, we depend on the support of donors and community members, like you, to supplement our mission and ministry. Because of your continued support we are able to provide care and programming to individuals, their families and the community through our residential, educational and vocational programs.

## Opportunities for Transformation:

At Flat Rock our primary mission and ministry stems from our residential care, therapeutic programs and ongoing care of our residents.

### ONE DAY OF RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT: \$24

A donation of one day of residential treatment for a resident will allow us to offset the uncompensated portion of the cost of housing, meals, transportation, staffing, overtime and any medications that are required in our daily ministry.

### ONE WEEK OF RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT FOR AN INDIVIDUAL: \$168

Are you interested in making a larger impact on the residential treatment of our residents? Consider funding one week of residential care and programming for a resident. This investment would cover the uncompensated portion of the costs of meals, transportation, staffing, overtime and any medications and medical care required to provide outstanding services to one of our individuals for one week.

**ONE WEEK OF VOCATIONAL, EDUCATIONAL AND ACTIVE TREATMENT: APPROX. \$122**



Are you passionate about education, furthering the vocational options for adults with disabilities and giving our individuals opportunities for growth? Consider sponsoring one week of vocational, educational and active treatment for a resident. This investment would cover the costs of transportation to and from work or school, staff time,

materials for work or school, and any field trips associated with school and work projects for one individual.

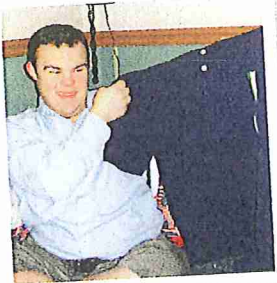

**ONE DAY OF UNCOVERED MEDICAL EXPENSES: \$40**

In order to provide the highest quality medical care to our residents we often cover medical expenses that may be only partially covered by Medicaid or which may not be covered by Medicaid at all. These can vary from medical equipment such as CPAP machines, to specific, necessary medications for our individuals. In order to meet their needs, it costs the agency \$40 per day to cover these costs. An investment in noncovered expenses ensures our residents and their families will never doubt they are receiving the highest quality care and that Flat Rock has resources to support each of our individuals.

**BACK-TO-SCHOOL CLOTHING FOR ONE RESIDENT: \$200**



Every child looks forward to a new set of clothes for their return to school in the fall. By investing in back-to-school clothing for a resident you will provide 3 new outfits, a new pair of shoes and a backpack. This cost also covers the cost of staff time and transportation to and from the store to assist our resident in selecting their new outfits.
